The *Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 Part VIII* requires registration to cover both the person carrying on the business and the premises used for that purpose. There are no powers to refuse registration, but the practice is controlled through compliance with byelaws in each case.

The applicant must ensure that the procedures, equipment and facilities used are safe, hygienic, prevent the spread of disease and comply fully with the general duty of care required by the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974.

It is illegal to conduct cosmetic piercing, tattooing, electrolysis or semi-permanent skin colouring unless the business has been registered.

Once an application has been made and the fee paid, an inspector will undertake an inspection of the premises to ensure compliance with the Barnsley bye-law requirements as well as ensuring that general health and safety requirements are being met.

The inspector will be pleased to offer any advice or give any help if you are unsure as to how to meet these obligations.
