




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Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. 
Overall Population

Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in Hoyland Milton has increased by 3.1% compared to 4.9% in Barnsley overall. The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. There are slightly more females than males within the ward.






Indices of Multiple Deprivation 2015

The Seven Domains of Deprivation and how Hoyland Milton Performs


Percentage of Hoyland Milton LSOAs in the Bottom 10% in England by Domain




Index of Multiple Deprivation 2015 Hoyland Milton LSOAs







The percentage of pupils resident in the Hoyland Milton ward achieving a good level of development decreased in 2018. Outcomes are now below both the Barnsley and national averages.


% of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018



The percentage of pupils resident in the Hoyland Milton ward achieving the expected standard in 2018 increased with outcomes now above both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018






The percentage of primary school pupils with special educational needs and disabilities decreased in the Hoyland Milton ward in 2018 remaining below both the Barnsley and national averages.



Life Expectancy at Birth




Life expectancy at birth for males in Hoyland Milton is 0.5 years higher than for men in Barnsley. The current rate of 78.6 years is the highest during the period 2012-2014 to 2015-2017.



Life expectancy at birth for women in Hoyland Milton is 0.2 years higher than that for women in Barnsley. The current rate of 82.1 years is the highest during the period 2012-2014 to 2015-2017.

Under 18's Conceptions




The under 18 conception rate in Hoyland Milton is lower than the overall Barnsley rate, and is the lowest during the period 2011 to 2015.




Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)


Hoyland Milton's under 75 mortality rate from respiratory diseases (38.8 per 100,000) is lower than the Barnsley rate of 41.8 .





The proportion of 4-5 year olds in Hoyland Milton who are overweight or obese (24.7%) is higher than the proportion in Barnsley overall (18.0%) and the highest rate since 2012-2013.



Hoyland Milton's rates for 10-11 year olds who are overweight or obese have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England at each time point during the period 2012-2013 to 2017-2018 but are currently at the lowest level since 2012-2013.

Breastfeeding






Over half of women in Hoyland Milton (57.3%) breastfeed their babies at birth; higher than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.



More than one in five adults in Hoyland Milton are smokers. The current rate of 22.8% is lower than the Barnsley rate of 23.4% and the lowest during the period 2013 to 2016.


Related Deaths per 100,000 (Over 35's)



Residents Living Alone and Aged 65+ Years












The 2011 Census showed that 12.6% of households in Hoyland Milton contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.







More than 6 in every 10 properties are owned with a mortgage or owned outright in Hoyland Milton. Ownership is similar to the Barnsley and England rates.










More than 1 in 5 properties in Hoyland Milton are social rented; this is higher than both Barnsley and England.

Private Rented








Hoyland Milton has more private rented properties than Barnsley but fewer than England.

Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are more Hoyland Milton households in Band A compared to Barnsley and England.

Total Crime (rate per 1,000 population)






















There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.


Robbery

All crime figures relate to the period January 2018 to December 2018.









Access to a Car or Van


