Background:

The issue was – Where works promoters have a permit and are carrying out the work (not Immediate works) on site, and unforeseen circumstances mean that works would no longer comply with the permit Conditions. Where changes are needed to the permit Conditions (other than the duration of the works), what should promoters do?

Advice:

Promoters should, in the first instance, telephone the relevant permit authority on the contact number(s) displayed on the authority's website, who will then manage the enquiry on a case-by-case basis.
