**All Hallows Church** – The Planning Inspectorate had refused the appellants appeal.

Jo Roberts reported that the next PACT meeting was to be held on July 1<sup>st</sup>.

Residents reported that two walkers had been rambling through the village naked. Whilst, not taken to be offensive, the residents were very bemused by the occurrence.

## **6. Environmental issues**

Residents reported that since the gates had been placed on the pull-in on Jebb Lane there was far less litter being dumped there. Litter picking continues to be done by the village group as a large amount of litter is dropped by passing cars daily.

The meeting was updated by Ward Cllr Burnett on the replacement of the TWIGGS Community service. A new approach to the way environmental services were being supplied in the Penistone area was being used and contracts had been signed and the services were about to commence. Further information will be provided when the service starts.

Residents complained about the condition of the roads around the village, particularly High Hoyland Lane. Ward Cllr Burnett said he would find out when this was due to be repaired.
