



Do you think a child is at risk of abuse?

You have a duty to report your concerns to the Children's Social Care Integrated Front Door (IFD).

To report your concerns about a child at risk of abuse or to discuss whether referral thresholds have been met, call:

- 01226 77 24 23 (before 5pm Monday-Thursday and before 4.30pm Friday).
- Contact the Emergency Duty Team out of hours on 01226 78 77 89 (after 5pm Monday-Thursday, after 4.30pm Friday, at weekends or bank holidays).
- Complete Barnsley Children's Services Request for Service Form and send a secure email to childrensintegratedfrontdoor@barnsley.gov.uk

Do you have a concern linked to the Prevent Duty?



If you are concerned a child, young person, adult or family is being radicalised or you have any concerns about terrorism and the prevent duty:

- Call the Police Prevent Team on 0114 252 3217 (8am- 4pm).
- Out of hours: dial 101 or in an emergency 999.
- Send a secure email to Prevent_Inbox@southyorks.pnn.police.uk

You should also make a referral to the Integrated front door about the child at risk - see procedure above.



If you are concerned someone who works with children poses a risk or you've had an allegation made about you or a member of your staff, (whether they are employed, a volunteer, apprentice or student), report your concerns to the Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO) by calling 01226 77 23 41 or 07969 52 97 79 LADO@barnsley.gov.uk

If they're unavailable when contacting by telephone, call the Safeguarding Unit on 01226 77 24 00 who will take a message, or alternatively email your enquiry to the LADO inbox. You will be contacted within 1 working day.

Advice MUST be taken from LADO BEFORE an investigation starts, and all allegations must also be reported to Ofsted.
