

UK Parliamentary Election For the Barnsley North Constituency

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that:

- 1 An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve Barnsley North Constituency.
- 2 Forms of nomination are available from the Acting Returning Officer, Boardroom, 2nd floor, Town Hall, Church Street, Barnsley, S70 2TA Monday to Fridays 8.30am to 4.30pm (excluding bank holidays).
- 3 Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, meeting room 6, 1st Floor, Town Hall, Church Street, Barnsley, S70 2TA from the 3 June 2024 to 7 June 2024 between 10.00am to 4.00pm and by no later than 4pm on Friday 7 June 2024.
- 4 Deposits of £500 are required for each candidate and can be paid by BACs transfer, legal tender, cheque or by banker's draft.
- 5 If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 4th July 2024.
- 6 The last date to register to be able to vote in this election is Tuesday 18th June 2024.
- 7 All applications in respect of postal voting and changes to proxy vote registrations must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Boardroom, 1st Floor, Town Hall, Church Street, Barnsley, S70 2TA by no later than 5pm on Wednesday 19th June 2024 if they are to be effective for this election.
- 8 New applications in respect of proxy voting must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Boardroom, 1st Floor, Town Hall, Church Street, Barnsley, S70 2TA by no later than 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024 if they are to be effective for this election.
- 9 Emergency proxy applications on the grounds of a medical condition, illness or disability, or where a person's occupation, service or employment means they are unable to attend at their polling station (and this could not have been foreseen before the deadline for ordinary proxy applications) must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Boardroom, 1st Floor, Town Hall, Church Street, Barnsley, S70 2TA by no later than 5pm on Thursday 4 July 2024.
