The re-development plans for the Fountain Inn site were of great interest and importance for the community, which has had no public venue available since the closure of the pub. The site had had two previous owners until the current ones, Conroy Brook, and their planning proposal was recently accepted by the borough authority. This has been broadly welcomed by the community as it is bringing back into use a valuable facility for the village.

The Covid pandemic and the restrictions brought in by government to control this, has had a big impact on community events such as the Fun Day, Remembrance Day and Christmas when people normally congregate, especially as the village has no community venue.

Finally, the year has seen three new Councillors welcomed to the Parish Council, in addition to a new Clerk.
