The above-named Order will come into effect on 21 November 2024 and is to make permanent changes to waiting and loading restrictions, disabled parking and loading provision, hackney carriage ranks, bus stop clearways and vehicular access into the pedestrian areas in the Barnsley Town Centre.

The following roads are affected: Albert Street East, Cheapside, Eldon Street, Kendray Street, Lambra Road, Market Hill Service Road, Market Street, May Day Green, Midland Street, New Street, Peel Square and Wesley Street.

Documents relating to this matter may be viewed on the Councils website and at the Library at the Lightbox in Barnsley Town Centre during normal opening hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within six weeks from 15 November 2024 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
